## Lounge



There are lots of different spaces at Narmbool.

This is the Lounge. It has comfy chairs and beanbags.

I can come here in my free time and relax. I can read a book, play a board game or talk with my friends.

Sometimes the Narmbool staff will talk to my whole group in here too.

## Dining Room



This is the Dining Room.

The Dining Room is joined to the Lounge

I will eat breakfast and dinner here, and sometimes lunch.

If it is a nice day, I will eat my lunch outside on the deck.

## Kitchen



This is the kitchen.

To keep us safe, my class and I will stay out of the kitchen.

The kitchen staff come and cook us our meals.

They will show me and my friends how to set the tables if we are on Duty Group.

I will make sure I always use my manners when I am talking to the kitchen staff.

## Arts Centre



This is the Arts Centre.

It is a classroom where I might do activities or watch and listen to a presentation.

I might also see a presentation in here.

I will be careful in the Arts Centre and just look at things, instead of touching things.

If I want to touch something, I will ask the Narmbool staff.



## Science Learning Centre



This is the Science Learning Centre.

It is another classroom where I might do activities.

I will be careful in the Science Centre and just look at things, instead of touching things.

If I want to touch something, I will ask the Narmbool staff.

## Homestead and Farm



There are other places at Narmbool I might visit as part of the activities I do at camp.

I might go to the Stables, the Homestead gardens or the Woolshed.

Narmbool is a working sheep farm, so I will also see lots of sheep.

The sheep don't like people and won't come near me.



## Mannas Outstation and Bowers



I might go on a walk to a place call Bowers. There is a special Aboriginal site and an old settlers house there to learn about.

I will be very respectful of these places and listen carefully to the Narmbool staff when they are telling me about them.

I might walk to Mannas Outstation to have something to eat or do an activity.

Some people can feel a bit tired when they go on this walk, but I can be resilient and have fun with my friends.

## Tea Tree Gully



Some camps that come to Narmbool will go on a longer walk to Tea Tree Gully Bush Camp.

At Tea Tree Gully Bush Camp there is a timber hut, a campfire and toilets.

If I go there I might play games, eat lunch and have fun.



## Cabins



I will sleep in a room with my friends. The room will have bunk beds and maybe some single beds.

Some people get sad if they don't get to sleep on the top bunk.

I know that it doesn't matter which bed I have, because I will only be in my room to sleep, shower and get dressed.

Only the people that are sleeping in my room can come in there.

## Cabin - Bathroom



When I shower at Narmbool, I need to push the button so the hot water will turn on.  
I can get in the shower and make it the right temperature for me.  
The hot water will only stay on for 4 minutes.  
I need to make sure that I wash myself quickly.
