## **Sovereign Hill to open on Thursday 23 September**

Delighted by the Victorian Government's announcement of the easing of restrictions in Ballarat, the not-for-profit Sovereign Hill Museums Association will open its Outdoor Museum, Sovereign Hill Hotel and Narmbool to the public from 10am Thursday 23 September.

Available through online booking only, tickets will cost \$39 for adults, \$20 for children or \$99 for a family of four, five or six. Visitors will be able to experience the excitement and life on the Ballarat Goldfields with much-loved activities such as the troopers and red coats, panning for gold in the diggings. Coach rides will also be available, along with street performances, regular musket firing demonstrations, gold pouring, candle making, blacksmithing and more.

To ensure Sovereign Hill is safe and secure, face masks are compulsory and physical distance signage and sanitisation stations are active throughout the site. The museum is taking these steps in line with government requirements as part of the current state-wide response to coronavirus.

Guests will be required to show ID demonstrating regional residency on arrival. Regular updates will be provided through Sovereign Hill's website and social media channels.

Extensions will be automatically applied to Annual Passes.
