## **Following the Victorian Government announcement of a continued lock down, the not-for-profit Sovereign Hill Museums Association has announced its Outdoor Museum and Narmbool will remain closed to the public until 10am Saturday 12 June.**

The Sovereign Hill Hotel will remain open and welcome guests from Friday 4 June and Winter Wonderlights remains scheduled to shine on Friday 25 June until Sunday 18 July.

Sovereign Hill will cancel all bookings, including AURA, up until and including Friday 11 June, and refunds automatically issued. Refunds will be received in the next 7 business days. Extensions will be automatically applied to Annual Passes. Visitors do not need to contact Sovereign Hill in order to receive refunds or extensions. Any future bookings on, or past Saturday 12 June, will remain and ticket holders will be notified if there is an extension to restrictions.

The museum is taking these steps in line with government requirements as part of the Victorian response to contain the spread of coronavirus and is closely monitoring developments. Regular updates will be provided through Sovereign Hill's website and social media channels.
